MEMORANDUM

The visit of the Minister of Education and Culture of the State of Israel, Shulamit Aloni, in Vienna in October 1992 and the visit of the Federal Minister of Education and Culture of Austria, Rudolf Scholten, in Jerusalem in November 1992, are the basis of this letter of intent outlining the cooperation and mutual understanding in the fields of education and culture of both countries.

As a result of the new relationship between Israel and Austria and the mutual desire to base the future cooperation on the respect of the memory of the past and on common efforts, the two Ministers agree on the following points:


I. Education


1. Exchange programs for pupils;
2. Exchange programs for experts on absorption, assimilation and integration problems;
3. Exchange of experts in technological education;
4. Cooperative school programs for both Jewish and Arab students;
5. Development of special programs for disadvantaged youth;
6. Cooperation on peace studies programs to help prevent the threat of xenophobia and anti-Semitism for young people.
