	He finished primary and grammar schools in Novo mesto.
1983	he began studying Slavic studies and philosophy at the Faculty of Arts of the University of Ljubljana, but changed to philosophy when a new programme was offered.
In the 1980s	he contributed to and edited the Novo mesto youth magazine Valj, was the editor for social issues at Radio Student between 1986 and 1988 and a columnist of the Mladina magazine.
1988	he left university and went to work for the Socialist Youth League of Slovenia with the mission to transform it into a liberal party.
1990	elected Deputy of the Socio-Political Chamber of the then Assembly, which voted for the country's independence.
March 1992	When Dr Janez Drnovšek took over the leadership he became Secretary-General of the Liberal Democracy of Slovenia.
June 2001	He resigned and returned to university to graduate in the next year with a thesis entitled 'When Philosophers Go Silent - the Case of Cratylus'.
