He is professor of Metaphysics and lecturer at the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences of the UAM, Universidad Autónoma de Madrid, where he studied his Licentiate degree and earned his Ph. D. with a doctoral thesis about Hegel called *"El concepto como experiencia y sistema"*. He has been president of the CRUE (Spanish University Rectors' Conference) until April 2009 and Rector of the UAM. He was Dean of the abovementioned Faculty during the years 1989-1992 and, previously, Vice Dean of Professorship for three years. He taught the core subject of Metaphysics, as well as the optional subjects of Hermeneutics and theories of the rhetoric, and Contemporary French thinking. He deals with issues related to the language and the possibility to think in some another way and to provide specific spaces to do it. He understands the philosophy as a lifestyle and studies the effect of these issues, particularly, in the contemporary philosophy.

Lecturer at the "Instituto de Estética y Teoría de las Artes", from the academic year 1989-90 until 1995, without interruption. Guest of the seminars at the *Centre Michel Foucault*, Bibliothèque du Saulchoir, in Paris, where the texts he has published about Foucault are located in the specialized bibliography. Member of the teaching and research team in the Third Cycle Programme on Phenomenology and Hermeneutics among seven European universities, from the Erasmus network. He has participated many times in the International Conferences of the Seminar Edad de Oro (UAM). Coordinator and Director of the International Third Cycle Programme *"Decir y no decir: el sujeto implicado"*. He has been president of CRUCE; (Contemporary Art and Thinking Association), from 1994 to 1997. He is

member of the Advisory Committee for several magazines (Azafea, Semiosis Ilimitada, Sileno).
