Since 2008	he has served as Chairman of the Board of the Association of National Creative and Cultural Industries. He is a member of the Lithuanian Artists Union
Since 2004	he served as a Vice Rector at the Vilnius Academy of Art before his appointment as Minister of Culture.
1995–1997	studied at the Tokyo University of the Arts. For many years, he worked as a lecturer at the Vilnius Academy of Art
1988–1994	studied Graphic Arts at the Vilnius Academy of Art He also took a postgraduate course at the Vytautas Magnus University, completing it with a PhD degree.
1975–1986	studied at the Kaunas J. Jablonskis Secondary School
