

**Annex to the
Joint Declaration on Cooperation in Science and Research**
between the Federal Ministry of Science and Research of the Republic of Austria
and the Ministry of Science and Technology of the Republic of Korea

Article 1

As agreed between the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology of the Republic of Korea (MEST) being the legal successor to the Ministry of Science and Technology of the Republic of Korea (MOST) and the Federal Ministry of Science and Research of the Republic of Austria (BMWF) on 12 May 2010 on the occasion of the Second Korean-Austrian Science Day in Seoul, the "Joint Declaration on Cooperation in Science and Research," which was signed on 3 April 2007, shall be prolonged until 20 September 2012 for the continued cooperation in Science and Research between the two countries.

During the prolonged period of the "Joint Declaration" both sides will mutually explore the possibilities of the conclusion of a governmental Scientific and Technological Agreement.

Article 2

Considering budget situations included in the second Korean-Austrian call for proposals that was jointly published in July 2010, both sides have agreed to change the wording of Article 3.2. of the "Joint Declaration on Cooperation in Science and Research" to the following:


"3.2. The exchange of scientists and experts for consultations, symposia, research projects and studies according to the work programmes of mutually agreed upon research projects."

Article 3

This annex shall take effect upon signing. The annex shall apply retroactive to 3 April 2010.
