He received several specializations in the fields of economics and political sciences. He published a range of scientific works and publications and participated in carrying out a number of important development projects in Montenegro.

- He was a member of the Parliament of Montenegro, Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs of Serbia and Montenegro, the Minister of Economy in the Government of Montenegro, and President of the Board of Directors of the Coal Mine, Pljevlja.

- 2011 He became the President of the Steering board of the club.

With the club and national teams during 2012 he achieved the greatest results in the history of Montenegrin handball: "Buducnost" won a Champions League Cup, the men's national team qualified for the World Handball Championship, women's handball team won silver medal at the Olympic games in London - the first Olympic medal for Montenegro, as well as the title of the champions of Europe.

His dedication and success in this sport are acknowledged at the international level.
