**Minutes of the meeting of the Evaluation Committee
for the selection of the PHC AMADEUS / WTZ-AMADEE projects for
2026-2027 within the scientific-technological cooperation between
Austria and France**

1. Exchange of information

Both sides informed each other about the recent developments. Both sides are satisfied with the long term, active and good cooperation within the PHC AMADEUS / WTZ-AMADEE Program. Both parties emphasize that a greater number of project submissions is desirable for this program.

2. Selection of co-operation projects for the period 2026-2027

16 eligible projects for the period 2026-2027 were peer-reviewed by both sides. Based on their scientific merits the Committee agreed upon funding mobility costs of 13 bilateral co-operation projects (Annex).

Only those projects that submit a midterm report after one year and which is adopted by both sides will receive a further funding for the second year. Both sides will inform each other on the decision not to fund a project for the second year.

3. Next call for proposals for the period 2028-2029

The next call for proposals will start in February 2027 and will close in March 2027.

4. Next Meeting for the selection of bilateral co-operation projects

The next meeting for the selection of bilateral co-operation projects for the period 2028-2029 will be held in Vienna end of October / beginning of November 2027. The exact date will be agreed upon by e-mail.


